## New Staff

Miss Morgan Currie has joined us as our Inclusion Manager and is responsible for overseeing the education for children on our SEND register; children who we receive additional pupil premium funding for and also children who speak English as an additional language. Morgan is an experienced special needs practitioner having worked in one of Canada's most prestigious special needs schools before relocating to England and specialises in supporting children with dyslexia and specific learning difficulties.

There are between 4,000 and 6,000 diagnosed genetic disorders and it is estimated that one in 25 children is affected by one of these genetic disorders and therefore 30,000 babies and children are newly diagnosed in the UK each year. Some genetic disorders are apparent at birth while others are diagnosed at different stages throughout childhood, and sometimes into adulthood. To raise money for this charity children will be asked to bring in one pound and wear as many items of denim clothing as they can.

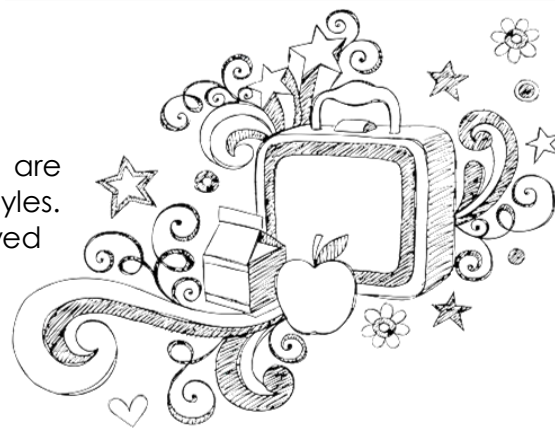
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## Packed Lunches

As an accredited National Healthy School, we are committed to promote and monitor healthy lifestyles. Please remember that the following items are not allowed in your child's packed lunch: fizzy drinks, nut based foods (Nutella, peanut butter) and sweets – including chocolate.



## School Uniform

Uniform is compulsory for all children currently in reception and years 1, 2, 3 and 4. Please ensure your child wears a green polo t-shirt, navy blue jumper or cardigan and dark coloured trousers or skirt (grey, blue or black). ALL CHILDREN should wear sensible dark coloured footwear. For safety reasons children are not allowed to wear jewellery, apart from studs or sleepers in their ears.

Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name! Embroidered uniform can be purchased from [www.tesco.com.ues](http://www.tesco.com.ues) and 'C' t-shirts and book bags can be bought at the school office.

## Collecting Your Child in Year 2 & Year 3

It is important that parents wait behind the white line, so the class teacher can safely hand over the pupils to their appropriate adult at home time.
