UNIVERSAL FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND FREE SCHOOL MEAL GRANT

As you may be aware from September 1st, every child in reception, year 1 and year 2, in state-funded schools, will be now offered a free school lunch (Universal Free Meal). We will assume that your child will now have a school meal unless you notify Mel in the school office that you would prefer your child to have a packed lunch.

However, it is important that we explain the difference between Universal Free School Meals and the School Meal Grant. If you are on any of the benefits listed below, you must apply for the Free School Meal Grant via Haringey Council, you can do this by completing the attached for and send it to:-

- Income Support
- Income- based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum act 1999
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more that £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Credit.

By applying for the School Meal Grant you could raise and extra £1,300 (Pupil Premium) for your child's school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities, so please ensure this is done as soon as possible if you have not done so already.
